

Program Manager/ Regional Service Coordinator for the DJJ Virginia Service Coordination Program needed to oversee all aspects of the Virginia Juvenile Justice Service Coordination Project for the **CENTRAL** region of Virginia (as defined by DJJ). - demonstrative interpersonal and cultural competency skills to work effectively with a variety of service providers, juvenile justice leaders/ administrators, and government policy staff.
- an understanding of or experience with Virginia systems, trauma-informed care, evidence-based principles
- strong computer skills
- openness to feedback and data-driven accountability
- ability and comfort with giving feedback and holding others accountable to quality assurance
- background (especially clinical or quality assurance role) with system-involved youth and families in Virginia is preferred.

Salary range is \$60,000-\$64,000, commensurate with education and experience. Strong preference for an individual living in the region; frequent travel around Central Region (including Lynchburg, Staunton, Charlottesville, Fredericksburg, and Williamsburg) and other localities is required.
